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

1 On September 1, 2017, petitioner Catherine Julie Golden ("Julie") filed a petition to
2 cancel ("Petition") the Third and Fourth Amendment to the Mattern 2003 Revocable Trust
3 Agreement (the "Trust") and powers of attorney and revocations. Julie filed an amendment to the
4 Petition on September 6, 2017. On September 14, 2017, respondent John R. Mattern ("John")
5 filed a Response to Julie's Petition ("Response") and a Cross-Petition to Surcharge Julie for
6 alleged breaches of fiduciary duty as a trustee of the Trust ("Cross-Petition"). John dismissed his
7 Cross-Petition on November 9, 2017, and the matter proceeded solely on Julie's Petition and
8 John's Response.

9 The Court conducted a hearing on the Petition and Response from November 5 to 8, 2018,
10 in Department E, the Honorable Jeanine Nadel Presiding. Michael G. Desmarais Esq., of the Law
11 Office of Michael G. Desmarais, and Steven P. Braccini, Esq., then of Hopkins & Carley,
12 appeared as counsel for Julie. Frank A. Cialone, Esq. and Roey Z. Rahmil, of Shartsis Friese,
13 appeared as counsel for John. The Court issued a Tentative Statement of Decision on January 29,
14 2019.

15 On or about February 14, 2019, the parties entered into a Stipulation of Settlement, which
16 the Court approved by Order dated February 15, 2019.

17 Pursuant to that Stipulation and Order, the Court hereby ORDERS, ADJUDGES AND
18 DECREES:

- 19 1. The Third Amendment to the Trust is cancelled;
- 20 2. The Fourth Amendment to the Trust is cancelled;
- 21 3. Any power of attorney executed by Richard Mattern and naming John Mattern as
22 attorney-in-fact for Richard Mattern is cancelled;
- 23 4. Any revocation of any power of attorney executed by Richard Mattern and naming
24 Catherine Julie Golden is cancelled, thereby confirming Catherine Julie Golden as Richard
25 Mattern's attorney-in-fact; and

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
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5. Julie is the sole trustee of the Trust.

6. The parties shall each bear their own attorney's fees and costs.
